
Pattern Designer

- Cooperating with the batik workers and staffs in the workshop to maintain and observe the production of the batik cloth with the chosen designs.



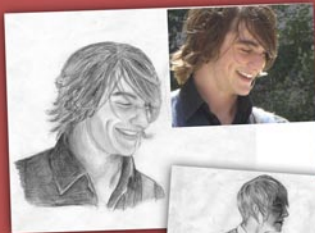
