1. Jengki Architecture: The Genuine Architecture Style project in Indonesia especially in Yogyakarta and Surakarta region. Supervised by Tariq Khalil, an English journalist, researcher, and photographer.
  2. Adaptation and Evolution of Toraja Traditional Building Structure. The study of Toraja building structure is a research project, based on several field trips between 2010 and 2012. The project aims at the investigation of adaptation and evolution of building structure of Tongkonan and alang as a representation of Toraja traditional architecture. The documentation and understanding of the traditional building structure evolution will help in the process of future development and building adaptation to environmental condition that may be of further use.
  3. Indonesia Traditional Architecture and its Conservation: Study case in Kabuyutan Trusmi, Cirebon. Kramat Mbah Buyut Trusmi is located in Trusmi village in Weru sub district, about 7 km west of Cirebon. Kramat Trusmi have a unique way to conserve its own traditional building, its called memayu (replacement of welit or palm-thatch roofs) and ganti sirap (replacement of sirap ow wooden roofs). Memayu is held once a year and ganti sirap once every four years, each is held at the beginning of the rainy season. This research is in collaboration with IAI National as the Nusantara Traditional Architecture Residency Program.
  4. Photography documentation of forts in Indonesia. I was conducted the documentation for Yogyakarta and Temanggung region, supervised by Pusat Dokumentasi Arsitektur Indonesia, Jakarta.

Several of my photos were featured in “Forts in Indonesia” book published by the Ministry of Education and Culture, Republic of Indonesia in 2013.
