

Optimizing the flexibility of space to get the wide impression of small space by joining multiple zones of activity and negate a massive barrier between space define by it's main function.






How to give a contemporarymodern-natural touch in a small space and keep it warm, and unweary.

Bed-Space as a more functionable as a contemplation space, reflection, evaluation, etc.





















Tamplas Chair


Concept:
